## Provision of NHS Stop Smoking Services and Community Pharmacy NRT Voucher Scheme - data reporting requirements

Following a recent case note audit carried out by the Specialist Stop Smoking Service, a number of issues were identified regarding record keeping for the above services. I am writing to highlight the data reporting requirements for these services.

To ensure service users are provided with effective continuity of care when accessing stop smoking services in Sunderland, it is important to record the support that they are given. It is also important to ensure that you receive the correct payment for the services you provide.

As you will be aware, there are different IT systems used for **each** service as follows:

Service	Supporting IT system	Purpose
NHS Stop Smoking	Call it Quits	Recording of stop smoking
Services		interventions and outcomes
Community Pharmacy NRT	PharmOutcomes	Recording of NRT dispensed via the
Voucher Scheme		NRT Voucher Scheme

All stop smoking interventions **MUST** be recorded on Call it Quits, and details of NRT dispensed **MUST** be recorded on PharmOutcomes. If you provide both services, you must use **both** systems.

Please find attached the service specifications for both services, which outline the service aims, objectives and include a detailed description of service requirements, including what information and data should be collected and recorded. Please see the following sections within each document:
